The purpose of this course is to train participants in the operation of fire fighting equipment and to make them aware of the fire fighting arrangements and the actions to be taken in the event of a fire on board ship.

The International Maritime Organisation (IMO) [www.imo.org](http://www.imo.org) and the Australian Maritime Safety Authority (AMSA) [www.amsa.gov.au](http://www.amsa.gov.au) require that all persons employed or engaged on a seagoing ship other than as passengers, shall receive approved familiarisation training or receive sufficient information and instruction in Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting.
