Course Aim

To provide terminal personnel involved in the acceptance and loading of dry bulk carriers with an education program that enables them to understand and comply with the IMO "Code of Practice for the Safe Loading and Unloading of Bulk Carriers", and to recognise this by the award of a Certificate in Safe Bulk Loading Practice.

Content

This certificate is conducted in two parts:

Part 1: Self paced study

A distance education package comprising an interactive study guide which incorporates activities relevant to the subjects in the course and includes reading material. The self study unit is designed in six modules, and candidates are required to complete an assignment upon completion of the units.

- General Commercial and Shipping Knowledge
- Knowledge of the Code
- Pre-Arrival Procedures
- Pre-Loading Procedures
- Loading
- Completing a Safe Loading Process

Part 2: 2-day workshop

On completion of part one, including the assignment, participants are eligible to attend a two day workshop of approximately 12 hours duration.

- Summarise and review aspects covered in the distance education package. This provides participants with an opportunity to ask questions or seek clarification on matters covered in the distance education package.

- Introduction to Critique
