Course Aim

This course is aimed at upgrading skills and knowledge of shore-based supervisory staff and shipping officers in ship and cargo operations. The course can be adapted for shore-based staff dealing with dry bulk or container/general cargoes. The course gives participants an overview of the operational, as well as the commercial and legal issues pertaining to the movement of cargo, shipping arrangements, charter parties and ship loading considerations such as stability and hull stress, load planning and ballast control. In addition, IMO Conventions and Codes of Safe Practice pertaining to stevedoring matters are discussed, together with cargo claims, casualties and consequences.
