Who needs a STCW Basic Safety Training /Certificate of Safety Training? If you intend to work in the maritime industry overseas, whether within the merchant or Superyacht field, the Certificate of Safety Training is the minimum qualification you will require. It is not possible to gain employment in the industry without this Certificate.

Course Aim

The 'Certificate of Safety Training' (sometimes known as STCW Basic Safety Training) is an internationally recognised certificate and is the mandatory minimum requirement in order to serve onboard vessels in international waters.

Applying for the Certificate of Safety Training

Upon successful completion of the AMC training, participants will be issued with AMC Certificates for each of the courses completed. Participants are then required to apply to AMSA for the issue of a Certificate of Safety Training. Application forms are available from the AMSA website: <http://www.amsa.gov.au>

The exemption would reduce the duration of the course; however the course fees remain the same.*

Physical Fitness

This is in part a practical course and all attending are required to participate in drills which require the use of fire fighting appliances and equipment, fire fighting agents and breathing apparatus. Some of the exercises are conducted in confined spaces, are strenuous and require a reasonable degree of physical fitness.

Participants should be medically fit, those who require medication for breathing problems are advised to ensure they have supplies with them on practical fire fighting days.

Safety Information

Course participants are requested to note the following safety information:

Enclosed footwear must be worn at all times. The AMC Occupational Health & Safety requirements will be adhered to throughout the course. Government regulations prohibit smoking in classrooms or within 10 metres of buildings.

What to Bring With You

AMC provides protective equipment such as: boots, leggings, coat, gloves and hard hat. Participants must provide their own: overalls, socks, underwear, towels, etc. and adequate spares.

It is strongly recommended that participants remove all jewellery prior to the practical exercises. Please ensure your jewellery is removed and safely stored prior to the practical exercise.

Delivery Strategy

The course will be delivered by classroom theory sessions and practical hands-on training sessions.
