## Course Aim

To provide participants with the skills and knowledge required to respond effectively as a key member of the on board command fire fighting team and manage shipboard fire prevention, co-ordinate tactical fire fighting and use and maintain fire fighting and fire detection equipment carried on merchant ships.

## Course Times

Days 1 and 2: 0900 - 1700

Days 3 and 4: 0800 – 1700 (*May vary on individual timetables*)

- Organisation of fire parties
- Organisation of on board training in fire fighting activities
- Management of tactical fire fighting activities for various vessel types and spaces
- Management of fires involving hazardous cargoes and materials
- Co-ordination and liaison with shore-based emergency services
- Supervision of inspection and maintenance of fire detection and suppression equipment

## Physical Fitness

This is in part a practical course and all attending are required to participate in drills which require the use of fire fighting appliances and equipment, fire fighting agents and breathing apparatus. Some of the exercises are conducted in confined spaces, are strenuous and require a reasonable degree of physical fitness. Participants who require medication for breathing problems are advised to ensure they have supplies with them on practical fire fighting days.

## Safety Information

Course participants are requested to note the following safety information: Enclosed footwear must be worn at all times. The AMC Occupational Health & Safety requirements will be adhered to throughout the course. Government regulations prohibit smoking in classrooms or within 10 metres of buildings.

## What to Bring With You

Participants must provide their own: overalls, socks, underwear, towels, etc. and adequate spares.
