This course is designed to provide participants with the skills and knowledge required to react appropriately in an emergency situation where a casualty has been injured at sea or is acutely ill, and to use those items of first aid equipment found in the ship's medical outfit which are not included in the standard first aid kit.

- Main body structures and functions
- Resuscitation techniques
- Initial patient assessment
- Managing medical emergencies
- Managing injuries
- Treatment of commonly encountered industrial related medical conditions
- Prevention of disease in seafarers
- Treatment of central nervous system and cardiovascular disorders
- Treatment of infectious diseases
- Managing surgical emergencies
- Managing sexually transmitted diseases
- Care of dying or dead persons
- Managing alcohol and drug abuse
- Radio medical advice
- Quarantine procedures
- Shipboard hygiene and health education

## Maritime Training Package

The University of Tasmania, trading as the Australian Maritime College (AMC) is a registered Training Organisation and has a partnership agreement with AMC Search Ltd. This enables AMC to award Statements of Attainment within its scope of registration where short courses administered by AMC Search have been deemed equivalent to units of competency within the Maritime Training Package. This is identified throughout the programme by the unit title and code from the Maritime Training Package. Units delivered under the Maritime Training Package are GST free.

## Delivery Strategy

The course will be delivered by classroom theory sessions and practical hands-on training sessions.

Phase 1: Medical Training for Shipmasters Course

Five and a half days instruction which is provided by staff of the School of Nursing and the Department of Rural Health, University of Tasmania (Launceston campus) and visiting medical practitioners.

Phase 2: Ambulance Experience

Participants attend shifts with the Ambulance Service, to gain 10 hours exposure to trauma and care of the sick and injured.

Phase 3: Hospital Experience

One session of four hours casualty experience at the Launceston General Hospital.

Note - Ambulance and Hospital Experience:

Participants should plan on attending the practical sessions on the Saturday and Sunday immediately following the course completion.

## Assessment Strategy

The participant will be assessed using the following methods:

- Short answer written examination
- Group discussion
- Role Play
- Case Studies

## Conditions of Assessment

This module provides for assessment off the job utilising facilities which simulate the workplace where appropriate.

The participant will be provided with:

- Appropriate marine medical publications.
- Medical stores and supplies commonly found on ships.
- A ship mock-up for practical and role play exercises.
