To ensure that participants with immediate responsibility for cargo operations (as per IMO STCW Reg. V/1) gain a thorough understanding of safe, pollution-free handling and transportation and to enable them to supervise and train other personnel in operational procedures.

To provide Masters, Chief Engineers, Chief Mates, Second Engineer Officers and any person with immediate responsibility for loading, discharging and care in transit or handling cargo with the ability to comply with requirements of Section A-V/1, Para 2-7, 9-14, and 16-21, STCW78 as amended, by providing the theoretical and practical knowledge of subjects specified in Paras 16-21 of Section A-V/1.
