Dockmaster training is offered in either:

- A 2-day course designed to provide candidates with the training required for the safe docking and undocking of commercial vessels into and out of dry docks (i.e. graving docks, floating docks, slip ways and synchrolifts); or
- A 7-day comprehensive course covering all aspects of dockmaster training

The course is usually delivered at the dock site, and can be tailored to cover specific aspects relating to the functions and characteristics of that particular dock.

Content (2 days)

- Theory of ship's stability before and during draining of the dry dock.
- Preliminary study and work to be carried out prior to the dry docking of a vessel.
- Required documents and drawings of the vessel concerned.
 - Dry dock particulars, e.g. dimensions, type of floor, acceptable draught, electric power supply, crane lifting capacities, fire fighting provisions etc.
 - Dry dock designs and functions.
 - Ship's (block) supports, scaffolding and other service systems.
 - Environmental safe practices. Implementation and policing of safety instructions.
 - Checks to be carried out during ship repair and maintenance.
 - Stability calculations and water tightness checks to be carried out prior to undocking of the vessel.
 - Undocking procedures.
