Course Entry Pre-Requisites

Please note in order for enrolment to be accepted, the below pre-req evidence must be provided at enrolment point:

A Certificate of Proficiency in Survival Craft and Basic First Aid Certificate (including resuscitation techniques) attained in the past two years, from a nationally recognised provider or verified continual sea service within the past two years, or an Australian issued Certificate of Competency.

Course Aim

This course is designed to provide participants with the knowledge and skills to safely operate a Fast Rescue Craft (FRC) and handle a casualty in a FRC. The course will be delivered by classroom theory sessions followed immediately by practical hands-on training sessions.

Content

On successful completion of the course, the student will be able to:

- Describe the design characteristics and capabilities of fast rescue boats.
- Describe the design characteristics and capability of fast rescue boat launching appliances.
- Demonstrate the ability to start and operate a fast rescue boat engine and its accessories.
- Demonstrate the safe launch of a fast rescue boat.
- Demonstrate basic fast rescue boat handling skills.
- Demonstrate casualty handling techniques.
- Demonstrate the use of search patterns in a fast rescue boat.
- Describe the actions to be taken in emergency situations associated with a fast rescue boat.
- Demonstrate the safe recovery of a fast rescue boat.

Course Times

Days 1 & 2: 0900 - 1700, Day 3: 0900 – 1300 (*may vary on individual timetables*)

Course Approval

Assessment Strategy

A supervised assessment will be conducted as to the achievement of each of the learning outcomes both by individuals and as a group using continuous practical assessment.

Physical Fitness

This course involves practical and theoretical sessions. The practical sessions simulate 'real-life' situations, utilising fast rescue vessels, and parent vessels in open water exercises. The very nature of Fast Rescue Craft and their function is fraught with potential danger, particularly given that their deployment is determined by necessity to rescue people, and prevailing conditions, such as weather, sea state, etc become secondary considerations.

While the AMC course is conducted under supervised conditions, participants are urged to maintain an awareness of their personal safety and ensure all instructions are followed.

Safety Information

Course participants are requested to note the following safety information:

Enclosed footwear must be worn at all times. The AMC Occupational Health & Safety requirements will be adhered to throughout the course. Government regulations prohibit smoking in classrooms or within 10 metres of buildings.

What to Bring With You

AMC provides equipment such as: lifejackets, waterproof suits, etc.

Participants must provide their own: suitable footwear, overalls, socks, underwear, towels, etc. and adequate spares.
