Course Aim

This course is designed to familiarise candidates with the handling characteristics of larger tonnage vessels and to instruct students, and assess their competency, in the safe navigational management of larger tonnage vessels, utilising the AMC Bridge Simulator.

- Collision avoidance
- Navigation through a congested anchorage
- Turning techniques
- Interaction and UKC effects
- Tidal considerations
- Anchoring a large vessel
- Voyage planning for a large tonnage vessel involving
- Berth to berth
- Navigation under pilotage - simulated errors by pilot
- BRM principles utilised
- Port entry plan under pilotage
- Adverse weather considerations in the navigation and handling of a large tonnage vessel
- Hull stresses
- Damage from cargo and container damage
- Heaving to
- Holding ground - anchorage considerations
- Navigation of a large tonnage vessel in restricted areas such as the Great Barrier Reef involving a passage plan.
